

After writing of the "one question which has been much controverted," that is, "the personality of the Spirit," he described the "Spirit of God" as "that awful and mysterious power which proceeds from the throne of the universe." (Quote from Ministry magazine, April 2012)

J.N Andrews wrote in the Review and Herald, March 6, 1855 -

"The doctrine of the Trinity which was established in the church of Nice, AD 325. This doctrine destroys the personality of God, and His Son Jesus Christ our Lord.."

"Adventist beliefs have changed over the years under the impact of 'present truth'. Most startling is the teaching regarding Jesus Christ, our Saviour and Lord...... the Trinitarian understanding of God, now part of our fundamental beliefs, was not generally held by the early Adventists." - Adventist Review, Jan 6, 1994. "Factual evidence that the SDA Trinity IS the Catholic Trinity. This should alarm any clear-thinking prophecy students. Time to wake up, folks!"

Brother Mueller, former German SDA Pastor (93 years old) -

"Back then the father of our president of the general conference (Neal Wilson) introduced the 26 or 27 Fundamental Beliefs. They were intended to be obligatory for all believers worldwide. But I and many other pastors did not accept them, because the Trinity isn't a Biblical doctrine. It originated in the 4th century AD in Nicea and Constantinople."

David Barron, founder and publisher of "The Third Angels Message.com" -





Some History on John Knox

Knox was ordained a Catholic priest 1536. Around the year 1547 he became converted to Protestant faith. He became a powerful preacher in Scotland. He also began to warn against the many Catholic false doctrines. During his preaching there was often heated emotions expressed as this was the time of the newly formed reformation.

In 1549 he went to England. In the same year he was licensed to work in the Church of England. In 1551 he was appointed one of six chaplains to the king. For the next few years he travelled around Europe. Settling in Geneva, Switzerland for a while. !959 he returned back to Scotland and gave many powerful sermons in various churches.He was born in 1514 and died in 1572. He was the founder of the Presbyterian Church, which today numbers about 2 million. (source Wikipedia)

Presbyterian Creeds of Confession

Chapter 12 - Faith in the Holy Ghost

"Our faith and its assurance do not proceed from flesh and blood, that is to say, from natural powers within us, but are the inspiration of the Holy Ghost; whom we confess to be God, equal with the Father and with his Son, who sanctifies us, and brings us into all truth by his own working, without whom we should remain forever enemies to God and ignorant of his Son, Christ Jesus.... And so, as we confess that God the Father created us when we were not, as his Son our Lord Jesus redeemed us when we were enemies to him, so also do we confess that the Holy Ghost does sanctify and regenerate us, without respect to any merit proceeding from us, be it before or after our regeneration. To put this even more plainly; as we willingly disclaim any honor and glory from our own creation and redemption, so do we willingly also for our regeneration and sanctification; for by ourselves we are not capable of thinking one good thought, but he who has begun the work in us alone continues us in it to the praise and glory of his undeserved grace".
